SMART Scholars are:

- Outstanding students with demonstrated ability and special aptitude in Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics (STEM) fields.
- Employed, post degree, as a civilian employee of the DoD, at DoD labs such as the National Security Agency, AFRL, SPAWAR, and the National Geospatial Intelligence Agency. Length of employment is commensurate with length of scholarship funding.
- Undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral students.
- Enrolled, accepted, or seeking acceptance at a U.S. college or university (undergraduate applicants must be currently enrolled and funding may only be applied to sophomore, junior, and/or senior year of study).
- At least 18 years of age and are United States citizens or nationals.
